

Donations to the Collection

Kitchener Public Library is not accepting donations to the collection at this time.

Please contact other local organizations listed below to find out if they are accepting donations.

Donations of materials are evaluated according to the same selection criteria that govern the acquisition of purchased material.

The Library reserves the right to refuse donations of materials that may not be in accordance with the Resource Development Policy.

Materials donated become the exclusive property of the Kitchener Public Library. The acceptance of a materials donation does not mean that the Library will automatically add the donation to the collection. Such gifts may be assigned initially to the branch of the donor's choice but must be available for use system wide. Items may be sold or discarded as the Library chooses.

For all collections, except local history:

- The Library will accept materials in new or nearly new condition including hardcover books five years old or newer, paperbacks three years old or newer, literary classics in good condition, undamaged DVDs and music CDs with the original jewel cases and booklets.
- Dated, yellowed, damaged or musty items will not be accepted. Nor does the Library accept condensed books, videocassettes, text books, CD-ROMs, magazines or newspapers.

For the specialized local history collection, the Library will accept archival materials which meet the local history selection criteria.
